2. Hydrants shall be fully opened and controlled with meter valve.
3. Equipment shall be stored in a safe place and shall not be left in the open or attached to a hydrant overnight.
4. All customers shall use **APPROVED** backflow prevention.
5. Individual listed above shall be held responsible for loss or damage to hydrants or equipment issued.
6. Water passing through this equipment is **NOT SAFE FOR DRINKING**.
7. Not complying with usage rules or excess damage will prohibit further use of hydrants and/or equipment.
