Unless circumstances require pre-payment, permit and restoration fees will be billed to the applicant upon completion of repairs. All repairs will be done by the City of Holland unless prior approval has been granted to the applicant to do or to contract for repairs. It is the applicant's responsibility however, to compact, backfill, and provide a temporary surface to make any street right-of-way excavation safe and travelable.

The applicant hereby agrees to defend, indemnify, and save harmless the City of Holland, its officers, agents and employees from any and all loss or damage, including but not limited to damage to the City's public streets and appurtenances, by reason of granting this permit or work done in the public right-of-way, including reasonable attorney fees and costs, and further warrants that he or she has in effect at the time of application for permit and at the time of doing the work authorized herein a valid policy of insurance in the amounts specified by city regulations naming the City of Holland as an additional insured party for general liability, automobile liability, and excess liability policies.

The applicant further agrees to safeguard the work site at all times, including compliance with the Michigan Uniform Traffic Control Devices and all other applicable standards, and to promptly pay to the City any bill rendered for permit fees and restoration work that is done pursuant to the issuance of this permit. The issuance of the permit does not alleviate the applicant's responsibility for obtaining and complying with any other permit that may be applicable, including but not limited to Michigan Department of Transportation permits for work in trunk line highways or CSX permits for work adjacent to railroad tracks.

As a condition of this permit, the applicant must give notice to all public utilities and notification recipients in accordance with Act 53 of the Public Acts of 1974, as amended, and comply with all requirements of said Act.
