Effective Date:

Rates effective for bills issued on or after July 1, 2018.

Readiness to Serve Charge:

Monthly Charge is the sum of the charges listed below.

- Readiness to serve charge per meter
- Plus commodity
- Plus applicable additional charges

Terms and Condition of Service:

All active accounts will be billed the readiness to serve charge based on meter size. The readiness to serve charge applies to all customers with connected public or well water supplies. Readiness to serve charge is not pro-rated.

Residential:

Metered customers are billed actual usage for the consumption months of December through April which is the base period. The lesser of the average monthly usage during the base period and actual monthly usage shall be applied to bills that are due between May and November.

Customers with metered private well water supply are billed the readiness to serve charge plus commodity charge. In addition, the customer will be billed all costs associated with maintaining the meter.

The unmetered customer flat charge is calculated as the residential readiness to serve charge plus the average residential usage of seven ccf.

Commercial and Industrial:

Customers are billed based on total water metered, unless provisions are made for metering the actual quantity of wastewater discharged into the system.

Commercial and Industrial customers will be charged the readiness to serve charge based on meter size.

Customers with subtract meter(s) may receive a discount on the readiness to serve charge for each account. The discount is the sum of the readiness to serve charge(s) of the subtract meter(s). The maximum discount is equal to the readiness to serve charge of the meter one size smaller than the main water supply meter(s).

Customers discharging compatible pollutants in excess of the Sewer Use Ordinance limits are subject to surcharges. Customer requiring monitoring and inspection services by Sewer Use Ordinance are subject to pollution control fees. Please refer to the **Wastewater Surcharge Rates and Pollution Control Fees schedule.**

Service will be further governed by the Holland Board of Public Works Terms and Condition.
