Effective Date:

Rate effective for bills issued on or after July 1, 2018.

Readiness to Serve Charge:

Monthly Charge is the sum of the charges listed below.

- Readiness to serve charge per meter
- Plus commodity
- Plus applicable additional charges

Non-Standard Water Main Rate:

Customers connected to a water main that was determined to be non-standard at the time it was added to the public water system will be charged a 30% surcharge on the readiness to serve and commodity rate charges for a period of ten years beginning on the date the water main is made part of the public system. The surcharge percentage and time period of this Rate in effect when applied to a customer will remain constant. There is an agreement with Laketown Township effective January 2012.

Terms and Conditions of Service:

All active accounts will be billed the readiness to serve charge based on meter size. Service must be disconnected to eliminate the readiness to serve charge. Disconnect/reconnect fees may apply. Readiness to serve charge is not pro-rated.

Service will be further governed by the Holland Board of Public Works Terms and Condition.
