**Effective Date:**

Rates effective for bills issued on and after July 1, 2018.

**Availability:**

Public Lighting service is available in areas serviced by the Holland Board of Public Works (HBPW) electric distribution system.

Decorative Pedestrian Street/Security Lighting is available in areas serviced by HBPW underground electric lines.

**Applicable:**

The HBPW owns and maintains all the lighting equipment and appurtenances, and the Monthly Amount includes all energy, parts, and labor, except for lights designated as "Energy Only".

The "Energy Only" rate is available for municipal owned lights when the municipality assumes all costs for procurement, installation, maintenance and replacement.

Energy usage is based on average annual dusk to dawn power consumption which is calculated as 4380 hours per year. No discounts in the monthly rate will be made for timers, motion detectors or similar equipment.
