Application Checklist for Holland BPW Rebates

(All HBPW Residential Electric Customers)

- Complete Customer Information sheet and Rebate Worksheet (Pages 5 & 6)
- Copy of invoices/receipts indicating the make, model, payment in full, and date of purchase
- Proof of ENERGY STAR® certification is required for most appliance rebates (see page 3)
- An AHRI certificate is required for central air conditioning units and heat pump rebates. Go to www.ahridirectory.org to find your AHRI certificate.
- AC and heat pump tune-up rebates require a dated copy of the contractor's checklist. An AHRI certificate is not required for tune-ups.
- A tool recycling receipt is required for an electric tool recycling bonus rebate
- An electrical permit and proof of Level 2 charger or 240 V appliance purchase for electric panel upgrade rebates
- Copy of EV registration for Level 2 charger rebates (must match service address)

Application Checklist for Holland Energy Fund Rebates (City of Holland Only)

- Complete Customer Information sheet and Rebate Worksheet (Pages 5 & 7)
- Copy of invoices/receipts for heat pumps, air sealing, insulation, and/or EV charger indicating make, model, payment in full and date of purchase (as applicable)
- AHRI certificate is required for heat pump rebates. Go to www.ahridirectory.org to find your AHRI certificate.
- Copy of EV registration for Level 2 charger rebates (must match service address)

PLEASE NOTE: Holland Energy Fund Rebates (HEF) are only available to residents living within the Holland city limits who have completed the Home Energy 101 program.

Failure to provide required documentation may result in delay of receiving your rebate.

2026 Residential Rebate Programs Summary



Energy Waste Reduction (EWR) Program

Holland BPW has had an Energy Waste Reduction (EWR) program for more than a decade. This program provides incentives to help customers replace existing electric equipment with more energy-efficient options. Some examples of this program include buying ENERGY STAR appliances.

Recycling old freon-containing appliances is also incentivized since it allows their potentially harmful refrigerants to be safely recycled. See information on our website about how to receive a rebate for recycling freon-containing appliances.

Beneficial Electrification (BE) Program

Holland BPW is now offering Beneficial Electrification (BE) rebates to help customers replace existing fossil-fueled equipment, e.g., gasoline or natural gas, with more efficient electric equipment under the following conditions:

1. The operating cost to the customer is expected to be the same or cheaper
2. There is an estimated net reduction in the carbon emissions impact of the switch

Unless a BE measure meets these criteria, it is not incentivized as part of our program. Examples of BE rebates include switching from a natural gas furnace to a heat pump or replacing a gasoline lawn mower with a battery-powered mower.



Holland Energy Fund Rebate Program

For City of Holland residents who complete the Home Energy 101 program, Holland Energy Fund (HEF) provides rebates for many of the same energy efficiency measures as HBPW. Residents can receive rebates up to \$6,000 per household for:

- Heat pump HVAC systems
- Home air sealing & insulation projects
- Heat pump water heaters
- Level 2 Electric Vehicle Chargers

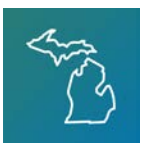

Holland BPW Income-Qualified Energy Efficiency Assistance

Customers who are at or below 80% of the area median income can receive up to \$5,000 per eligible household to complete energy efficiency upgrades. This program aims to reduce energy costs, improve comfort, and improve the health and safety of occupants.

State Incentive Programs

The [Michigan Home Energy Rebates Program \(MiHER\)](#) helps Michigan residents make their homes more energy-efficient and affordable. This program supports energy efficiency upgrades and electrification efforts for single-family and multifamily homes, reducing utility costs, improving comfort, and enhancing indoor air quality. Homeowners and renters are eligible, with standard rebates available for households earning 81-150% of the area median income (AMI) and enhanced rebates for households earning less than 80% of the AMI.

2026 Residential Rebate Program Equipment Specifications

General Program Rules – Holland BPW Residential Rebates

This offer is valid only for a limited time for Holland Board of Public Works residential electric customers. Offer is good while funds are available, on a first-come, first-served basis. The program begins on January 1, 2026. Your completed application and the required documents must be received by December 31, 2026, or within 60 days of purchase/invoice, whichever is later. Holland Board of Public Works reserves the right to withdraw or change this offer without notice. Rebates will not exceed the purchase price. Ineligible rebate requests are subject to denial or repayment to the program. All equipment must be new and installed or operated in a residential dwelling where electric service is provided by Holland Board of Public Works. Equipment purchased used, rebuilt/refurbished or open box are not eligible. An original receipt/invoice showing the date of purchase, purchase price, make/model information, and payment in full is required. If you are unsure if you are eligible for a rebate, please call 616-355-1577.

Equipment Specifications – Holland BPW Residential Rebates

Appliances: Room Dehumidifier, Refrigerator, Pool Pump, Electric Clothes Dryer, Heat Pump Clothes Dryer, Clothes Washer, Dishwasher, and Air Purifier must be ENERGY STAR certified. Refrigerator must be 10 cubic ft. or larger.

Induction Cooking Appliance: Ranges, cooktops, and single burner induction appliances are eligible.

AC or Heat Pump Tune-Up: A tune-up is a cleaning and inspection of the indoor and outdoor coil, which includes cleaning or replacement of air filter, inspection and lubrication of blower, cleaning/inspection and lubrication of motors, checking/adjusting the refrigerant, confirmation of proper airflow, checking condensate drain, cleaning debris from and around the condenser, and performing visual inspection of entire system. AC tune-up limit 1 per customer per year. Heat pump tune-up limit 1 per cooling season and 1 per heating season per customer per year.

Central Air Conditioning: SEER2 15.2 or 16+. The indoor coil and outdoor condenser must be a matched set and installed on the same date to be eligible. AHRI certificate must match model numbers on invoice.

HVAC Heat Pumps: Heat pumps must be the primary method of heating and cooling.

- Heat pump minimum specifications: HSPF2 \geq 8.1
- Both the indoor and outdoor models must be listed on the invoice, installed at the same time, and AHRI rated together.
- Mini-split tonnage is determined by the size of condenser (outdoor) units, not number of cassettes
- Self-installed units are eligible for rebates up to the purchase price of materials and require a finalized permit from the City/township.
- Rebates cannot exceed \$4,000.

Heat Pump HVAC rebates are available for residential dwelling spaces only. Non-eligible spaces include spaces that are not used as a dwelling space, such as a garage, hobby space, or outbuilding. ADUs may qualify if they meet the following: a) occupied full-time b) include a full bathroom and fully functioning kitchen c) separate ventilation from the primary dwelling.

There are two types of rebates for heat pumps, depending on any additional heat sources in the home.

The all-electric home heating rebate is available for homes with heat pumps as the sole source of heating and cooling. New or existing back-up heat sources must be electric.

Homes with new or existing non-electric heat sources, such as a furnace, to supplement the heat pump system are eligible for the dual-fuel rebate, provided the heat pump system is the primary method of heating and cooling the space.

Programmable Thermostat: Must be installed in a home with central air conditioning to qualify.

Heat Pump Water Heater: Must be ENERGY STAR certified.

Electric Lawn Tools: Holland BPW electric customers must purchase a qualifying electric lawn tool to receive the rebate. Any customer seeking the recycled tool rebate for a given tool must recycle an existing gas-powered tool of the same type (e.g., mower) and comply with the following: Drain the gas-powered lawn tool of all fluids and bring it to PADNOS Black River Recycling Center located at 11531 Chicago Drive, Holland, MI 49424; Ask for a Holland BPW recycling receipt. Residential customers must own the units being recycled. Limit one rebate (tool-only or tool-plus-recycle-bonus) for each type of electric tool per year.

NOTE: New construction may qualify for some (but not all) rebates described above. Please see www.hollandbpw.com for the New Construction rebate application.



EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS CONTINUED...

Panel Upgrades: Upsize an existing service panel capacity to a minimum 200 amp service or install a UL-listed and hard-wired load management device for a specific circuit. This must include the addition of a Level 2 EV charger or at least one 240-volt appliance electrification (converted from natural gas). A licensed electrician must complete the work. A copy of the finalized electrical permit is required. You will have 12 months from the panel upgrade to install qualifying equipment to receive the rebate.

LEVEL 2 EV CHARGER REBATE PROGRAM

Level 2 Charger Rebates: Include Level 2 charger invoice and copy of electric vehicle registration. Vehicle registration and HBPW account must have the same address. Customers who receive a rebate will have their whole house placed on the EV Time-of-Use rate for a minimum of one year. Declining the Time-of-Use rate forfeits the rebate. Go to the HBPW website to review the rate to make sure this rate fits your charging habits. Visit Hollandbpw.com/en/electric-vehicles or scan the QR code below.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- Program Participants shall agree to participate in the HBPW's Electric Vehicle Whole House Time-of-Use rate as a requirement of the rebate. Further details about this rate are contained in the HBPW Rate Book.
- The actual cost of the charger must be itemized on a paid invoice, installation contract, or purchase agreements. The rebate shall not exceed the cost of the EV charger. Participants are limited to one EV charger rebate per vehicle, per HBPW residence.
- The qualifying Level 2 (240-volt) EV charger must be: new and unused, certified by Underwriters Laboratories Inc. (UL Listed) OR ETL Listed. The EV charger must be wall-mounted. Portable chargers do not qualify unless a 240-volt circuit was added within one year of the time of purchase of the portable charger solely for the purpose of the portable charger. If a 240v circuit is added (to a garage for example) to accommodate a Level 2 240-volt charger that is portable, then the charger qualifies for a rebate. If the household service is upgrade to 200amps, see the residential rebate application for a service upgrade rebate.
- The Program application must be signed by the named customer(s) of record ("Participant") who permanently resides at the address provided and has an active electric meter served by HBPW.
- Program Participants must be in compliance with all federal, state, county, and city government regulations regarding the installation of EV Chargers, metering equipment, or any other support equipment required or necessary for the proper and safe installation of an EV Charger. In addition, the Program Participant has the sole responsibility of securing all necessary and required permissions from the property owner, homeowner association, or any other organization from which permission to make such installations would be required.
- The EV charger shall remain in service at the installation location indicated on the rebate application for a minimum of one year unless the HBPW electric service account is closed during the designated timeframe. Failure to adhere to the one-year service requirement may result in the forfeiture of all paid rebates, or a portion thereof, as determined by the HBPW.
- HBPW makes no warranties and is not responsible for any representations, whether expressed or implied, including but not limited to, any warranty of merchantability, fitness for a particular use product performance and useful life, or application of the item(s) or measure(s) by manufacturers, dealers, contractors, or any other third parties, materials, workmanship, the quality, safety and/or installation of the item(s) or measure(s), effects on pollutants or any other matter with respect to the Program. In no event shall the HBPW be liable for special, incidental, indirect, exemplary or consequential damages including, but not limited to, loss of use of the equipment or any associated equipment.
- HBPW may utilize, without compensation, the data generated by the use of the EV charger to improve HBPW services, conduct studies, or for any other purpose in furtherance of HBPW operations. Such data may also be provided to other entities for research and grant purposes and/or as required by law.

Contact your city or township as an electrical permit may be required. Your electrical service, depending on its age and size, may need to be upgraded to comply with the electrical code.

Holland Energy Fund rebates may be combined with applicable Holland BPW Energy Smart rebates but will not exceed the purchase price of any given efficiency measure. Pre-approval with the City of Holland is recommended to ensure project eligibility - call 616-355-1355. Total cost of measure includes labor and material costs if installed by a licensed contractor. If you self-install the measure, you can only receive a rebate on the purchase price of the materials. Ineligible rebate requests are subject to denial or repayment to the Holland Energy Fund. All equipment must be new and installed or operated in a residential dwelling within the City of Holland. Insulation rebates do not apply to new construction. The City of Holland reserves the right to perform an inspection of the installation.

- Program Participants must be in compliance with all federal, state, county, and city government regulations regarding the installation of EV Chargers, metering equipment, or any other support equipment required or necessary for the proper and safe installation of an EV Charger. In addition, the Program Participant has the sole responsibility of securing all necessary and required permissions from the property owner, homeowner association, or any other organization from which permission to make such installations would be required.
- The EV charger shall remain in service at the installation location indicated on the rebate application for a minimum of one year unless the HBPW electric service account is closed during the designated timeframe. Failure to adhere to the one-year service requirement may result in the forfeiture of all paid rebates, or a portion thereof, as determined by the HBPW.
- HBPW makes no warranties and is not responsible for any representations, whether expressed or implied, including but not limited to, any warranty of merchantability, fitness for a particular use product performance and useful life, or application of the item(s) or measure(s) by manufacturers, dealers, contractors, or any other third parties, materials, workmanship, the quality, safety and/or installation of the item(s) or measure(s), effects on pollutants or any other matter with respect to the Program. In no event shall the HBPW be liable for special, incidental, indirect, exemplary or consequential damages including, but not limited to, loss of use of the equipment or any associated equipment.
- HBPW may utilize, without compensation, the data generated by the use of the EV charger to improve HBPW services, conduct studies, or for any other purpose in furtherance of HBPW operations. Such data may also be provided to other entities for research and grant purposes and/or as required by law.

Contact your city or township as an electrical permit may be required. Your electrical service, depending on its age and size, may need to be upgraded to comply with the electrical code.
